



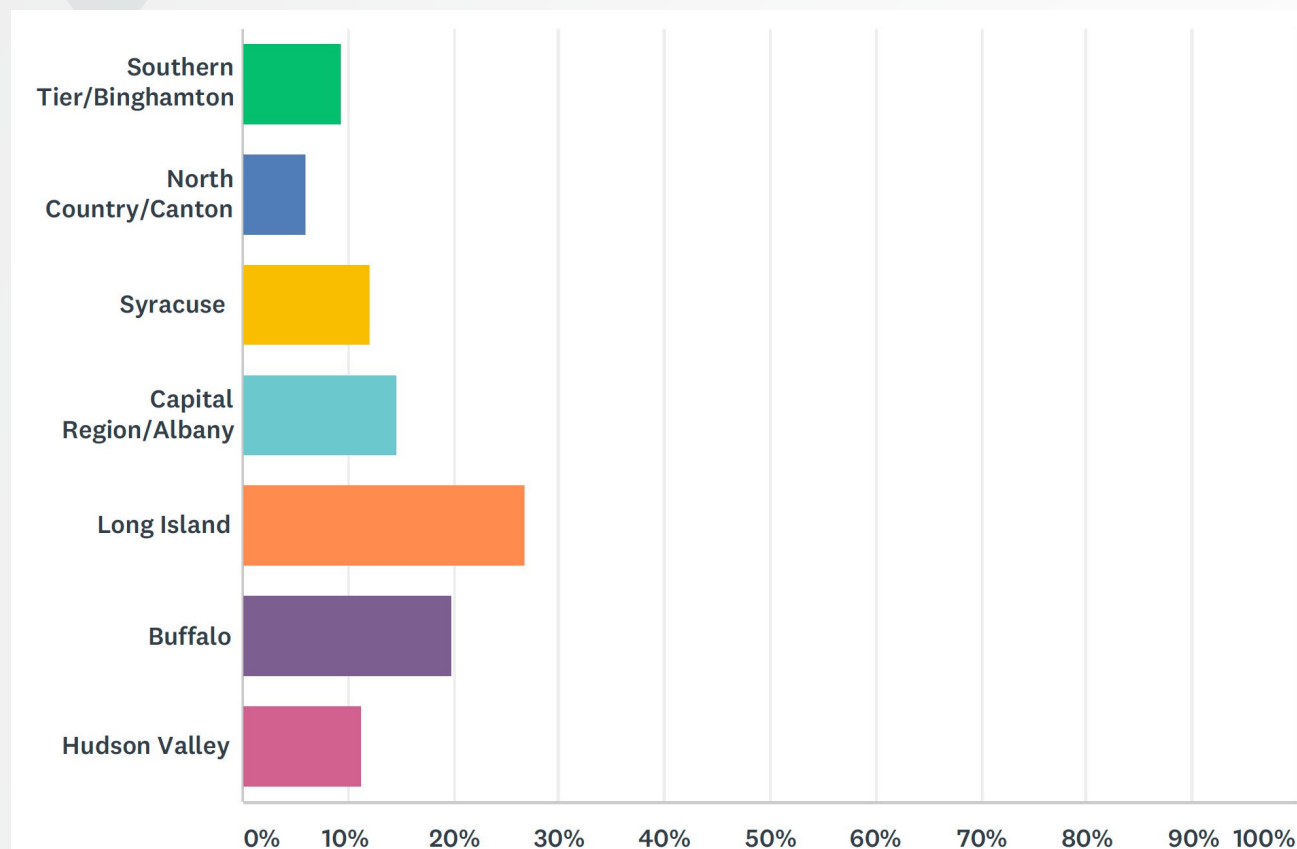

Q1 WHICH OF THE SEVEN STATEWIDE DATA MEETINGS DID YOU ATTEND?

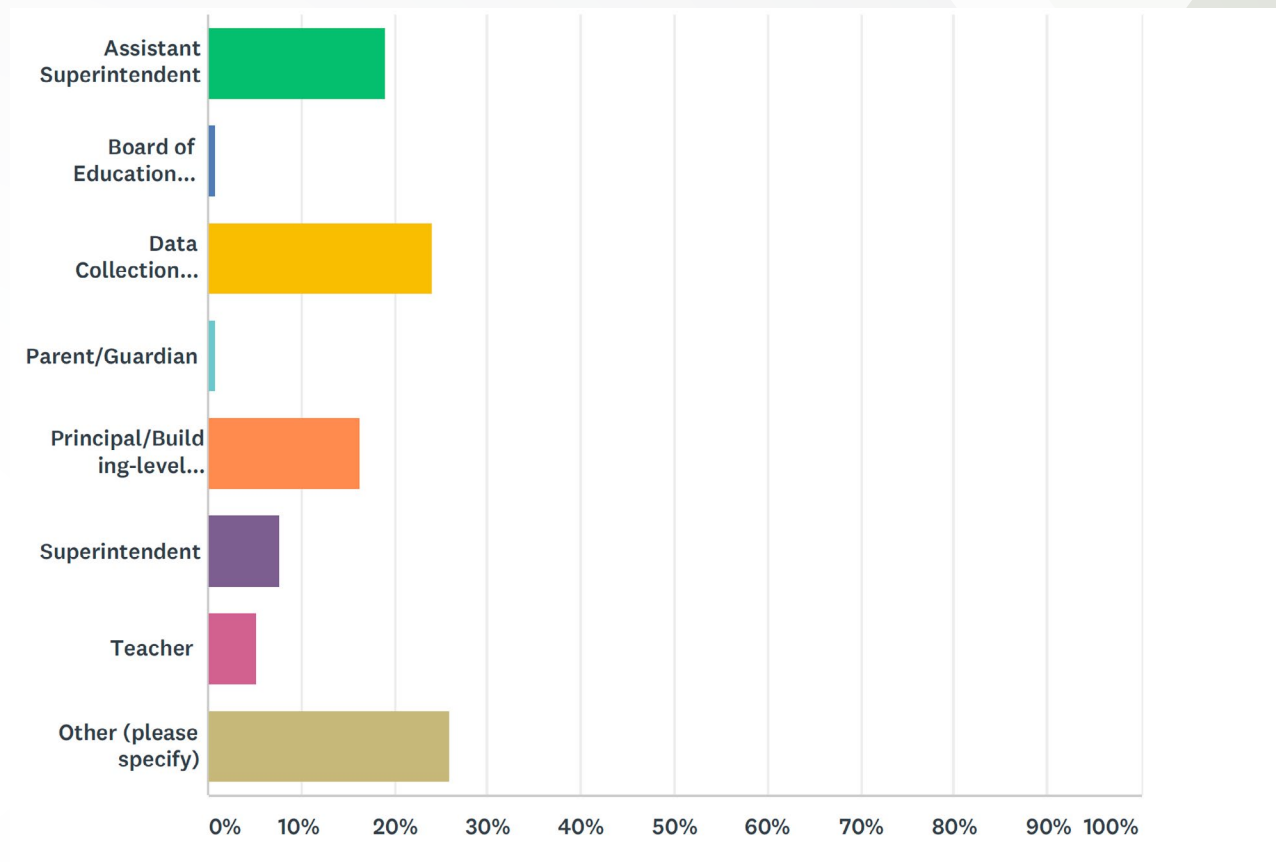

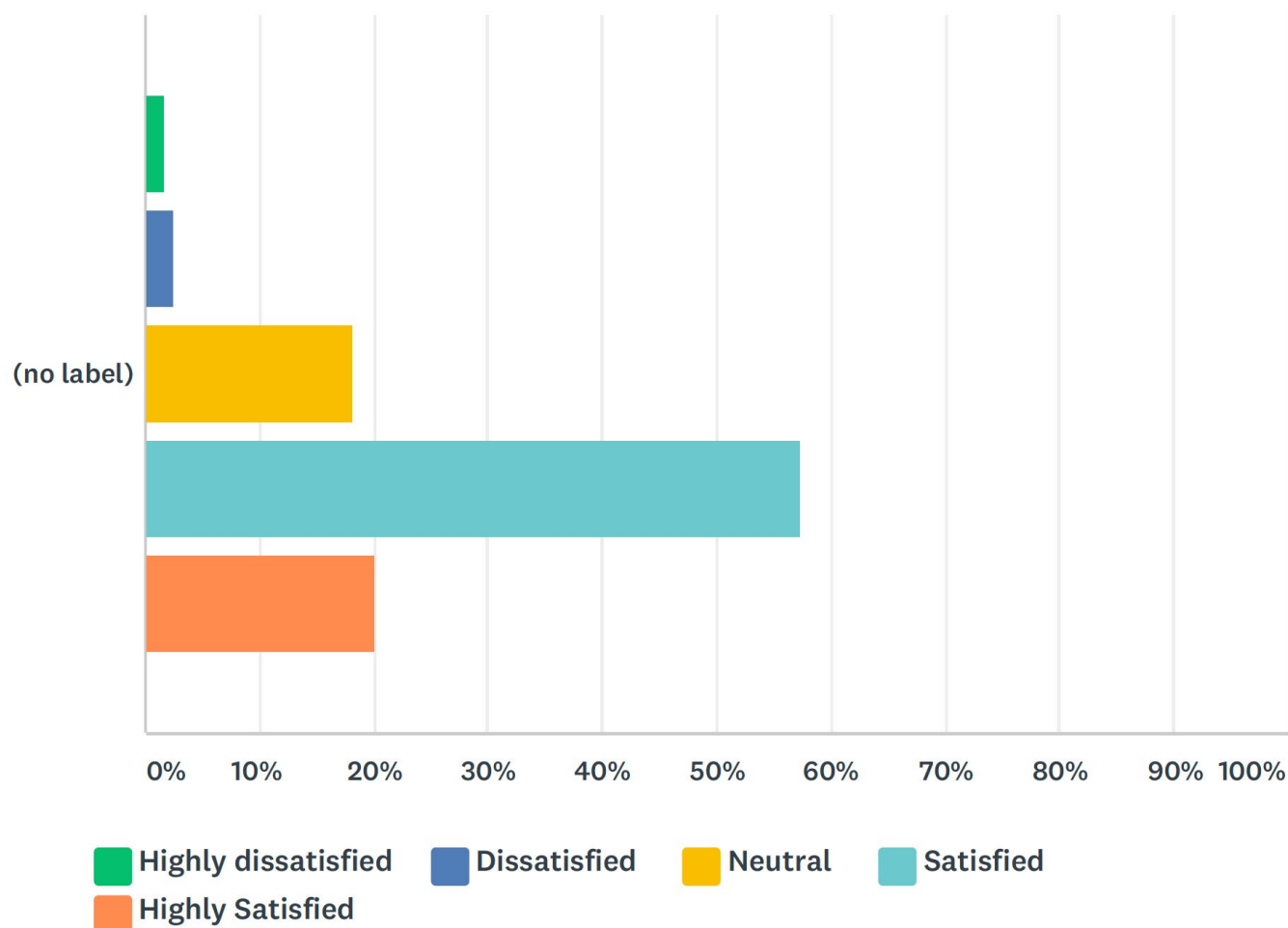
